Keuka Boating Regulations

As the boating season begins, here is a reminder of some of the NY State Boating laws applicable to Keuka (more detailed copies available in clubhouse).

Maximum Speed Limits

- 45 mph during daylight hours
- 25 mph from ½ hour after sunset to ½ hour before sunrise
- 5 mph within 200 feet of shore, docks, rafts or moored vessels

Boating Equipment

- All boats require one wearable PFD (Personal Flotation Device) per person.
- Children under 12 must always wear an appropriately sized PFD while on a boat under 26 feet when the vessel is underway.
- All motor boats must have a fire extinguisher on board.
- Motor boats 16 feet and over and sailboats under 23 feet must have a throwable PFD.
