Rule Reminders

Club Ground Rules prohibit parking cars on the lower club grounds on Sundays. The rule states:

No cars shall be allowed in the boat parking area on Sundays except for pick up and delivery of boats.

This rule has been overlooked in recent years. This is a reminder to those members who may not know about it. Two large parking areas exist across the road. Members are permitted to drop off their children or their supplies for the day, however, the car must then be parked across the road. This applies to Sundays only, however, the Board of Directors would ask that members park across the road whenever possible to keep the boat parking lot open. Thank you.

Another Reminder: Members are not permitted to bring alcoholic beverages on the club grounds. The club's liquor license is jeopardized whenever someone brings alcohol onto the grounds. Please be considerate of this rule.
