Art Wilder's grandson, Andrew Campbell of San Diego, California, won the Laser fleet. Art's daughter Sherry is married to Bill Campbell, and their son Andrew used to sail at Keuka on E-Scows with his father and grandfather. Andrew started sailing at the age of 5 and credits his father, a college All American and a navigator aboard one of the 1980 America's Cup boats, as the most influential person in his athletic career.
