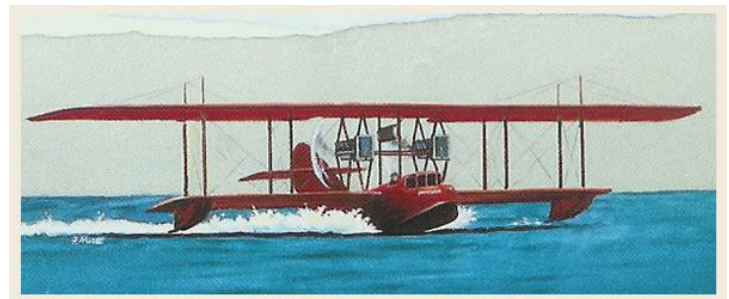
Clubhouse Hours
